WORLD MARRIAGE SUNDAY 12/13 February 2022

This weekend is World Marriage Sunday. Marriage Sunday highlights the importance of the sacrament of matrimony, affirms couples who strengthen our faith community through their witness, and complements World Marriage Sunday celebrations that take place across North America. It also honours those who nurture marriage ministries - marriage preparation, enrichment, etc. First celebrated in the Archdiocese of Toronto in 2011, His Eminence Thomas Cardinal Collins designated the weekend prior to the Family Day long weekend in Ontario as "Marriage Sunday".

2022 MASS OFFERINGS

According to the ancient and beautiful custom of the Church, the faithful, desiring in a religious and ecclesial spirit to participate more in intimately in the Eucharistic sacrifice, add to it a form of sacrifice of their own by which they contribute in a particular way to the needs of the Church, by way of making a donation for the celebration of the Mass for their intentions. In accordance both with the universal law of the Church (Canon 948: "Separate Masses must be applied for the intentions of those for whom an individual offering, even if small, has been made and accepted") and the particular norms of the Archdiocese of Toronto, in general, there is to be only one intention per Mass. As an exception, the Code of Canon Law allows for only one Mass per week to have multiple intentions, established on the same day and time each week, known to parishioners, and that Mass may never be on Sunday.

Accordingly, to ensure that St Joseph the Worker Parish remains faithful to the letter and spirit of the Church's law, and of our Archbishop, effective the first week of March, there can only be one intention per Mass. Requests to offer a Mass are done on a first-come, first-serve basis. An exception is made for Masses that are offered on Friday evening at 7:00 p.m., at which there will be multiple intentions for the one Mass.

Note that multiple intentions at any one Mass do not "dilute" the efficacy of the Holy Sacrifice. Each of those intentions are equally and perfectly close to the Heart of Jesus, and His Sacrifice will bring His presence and grace to those for whom the Masses is being offered.
