WHAT IS THE PRE-AUTHORIZED GIVING PLAN?

The Archdiocese of Toronto has introduced a Pre-Authorized Giving Plan to make it easier for you to support the work of St. Joseph the Worker Parish through your regular, mortgage, and ShareLife parish offerings (excluding special collections). Your donations play a crucial role in funding the work of our parish, and in response to changing lifestyles and demands, the Archdiocese of Toronto offers Pre-Authorized Giving to facilitate your contributions.

Participating in Pre-Authorized Giving may be a suitable option for you. By following a simple procedure for setting it up, you and St. Joseph the Worker Parish can benefit from it.

When you opt for Pre-Authorized Giving, your offering will be automatically withdrawn from your account on the 20th day of each month and deposited into the parish's account.



WHY SHOULD I PARTICIPATE?

Advantages for the Donor:

- Convenience: Your offering is automatically made every month.
- Continual support for your parish even when you are away.
- Continual support for ministries, charities, and programs funded through ShareLife.

Advantages for the Parish:

- Regular, dependable flow of contributions to the parish.
- Reduction of paperwork and bookkeeping.

HOW DO I ENROLL?

To make your offering through the Pre-Authorized Giving Plan:

1. Decide the amount you would like to gift to St. Joseph the Worker Parish and/or ShareLife to be withdrawn from your account each month.
2. Fill out the form on this brochure and attach a void cheque.
3. Place your form and void cheque in a sealed envelope and either drop it in the collection basket or mail it to the Parish Office.



WHO LOOKS AFTER THE PLAN?

The Office of Stewardship and Development of the Archdiocese of Toronto oversees the Pre-Authorized Giving Plan for the Parish. Our parish office will continue to issue tax receipts for all offertory gifts.

HOW WILL PRE-AUTHORIZED GIVING REPLACE MY CURRENT GIVING?

Offertory envelopes will still be issued to all parishioners. Those who have joined the Pre-Authorized Giving program need not place anything in the collection basket. Alternatively, they can simply put "P.A.G." on their offertory envelope and place it in the collection basket. All parishioners should continue to use the special collection envelopes.
